Shea butter is also known as „women's gold“ in Africa, because the task of collecting and processing shea nuts is traditionally carried out by women. The production of shea butter provides a livelihood for millions of women and their families in Africa. To ensure the special quality which is unique to handmade shea butter provides, our suppliers work together with the women of the

villages where shea trees are found, and on whose land they grow. The trees bear fruit for over 100 years and therefore provide a long-term source of income to the villagers.

### The manufacture of handcrafted shea butter

First, the pulp is removed from the fruit. Next, the women cook the nut kernels (1), lay them out to dry (2) and then grind them. This results in the forming of a brown, viscous mass which is stirred intensively for up to one hour, as water is continuously added to the mixture. (3) This is usually carried out by the women collectively, in the village square.
